**SCIENCE FAIR SUPPORT** - The Coalition provides a large purple ribbon for the most outstanding environmental project at each regional Science Fair. Ribbons and a \$50 cash award are given to the Junior and Senior winners at the State Science Fair.

**NATIONAL YOUTH SCIENCE CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS** – Annually in January, the governor asks C2E2 to coordinate the selection of two outstanding high school seniors to receive a full scholarship to attend the National Youth Science Camp. The month-long experience includes lectures and hands-on research projects; overnight camping trips; and a visit to Washington D.C. The selected delegates must demonstrate academic achievement in science and potential for thoughtful scientific leadership.

- ◆ selecting National Youth Science Camp scholarship winners for the governor from 2000 – 2017,
- ◆ securing affiliate membership from the NAAEE in 2011, and
- ◆ producing Trading Cards of trees, macroinvertebrates, and soils for study and use by teachers and natural resource professionals.
